YOU NEED TO GO/STAY HOME IF YOU HAVE:



1 OF THE FOLLOWING:

FEVER OF 100.4 OR HIGHER
SHORTNESS OF BREATH
DIFFICULTY BREATHING
COUGH
NEW ONSET LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL

OR

2 OF THE FOLLOWING:

HEADACHE
SORE THROAT
RUNNY NOSE/CONGESTION
CHILLS
MUSCLE PAIN
NAUSEA OR VOMITING
DIARRHEA



RETURN TO SCHOOL

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST

ISOLATE FOR 5 DAYS AFTER SYMPTOM ONSET
MAY RETURN DAY 6 IF AT LEAST 24 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT TAKING MEDICINE, SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED AND MUST WEAR MASK FOR ADDITIONAL 5 DAYS.

SYMPTOMS BUT NO COVID-19 TEST

ISOLATE FOR 5 DAYS AFTER SYMPTOM ONSET,
MAY RETURN DAY 6 IF AT LEAST 24 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT TAKING MEDICINE, SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED AND MUST WEAR A MASK 5 ADDITIONAL DAYS

NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST

AT LEAST 24 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT MEDICINE AND SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT OF SYMPTOMS

CLOSE CONTACT TO COVID-19

REMAIN IN SCHOOL, MASK FOR 10 DAYS AND TEST ON DAY 6 AFTER EXPOSURE.
IF SYMPTOMS QUARANTINE AND CONTACT PROVIDER
ISOLATE IF POSITIVE TEST
